

Equestrians Institute Dressage Schooling Show 2021 COVID-19 Plan

- 1) All persons entering the show grounds will be **required to wear a face mask at all times**, except while mounted on a horse.
- 2) Participants and volunteers will be directed to **stay home if they feel sick**.
- 3) There will be **no food service**.
- 4) The show will be held at the outdoor show facility in Bridle Trails State Park, Bellevue, WA
- 5) **No more than 40 participants** will be allowed. Each participant will be limited to be accompanied by no more than two adults. This will result in attendance being well below the max 200 persons allowed. **No spectators or vendors are allowed**. To enter the show grounds, you must be on the list as a rider or person accompanying a rider. Your show number will be handed out at this time.
- 6) We are planning to use a **paperless scoring and reporting system** to limit person to person contact. Ribbons will be available on an outdoor table.
- 7) The judge and scribe will sit at an outdoor table, six feet apart.
- 8) The **two warm-up arenas will be limited to 10 horses each**, which will allow for staying more than 6 feet apart. There will be a **separate entry and exit gate** into the show ring. There will only be one rider at a time in the show ring except for the Lead-Line class, where each horse must be at least six feet apart.
- 9) The show will **require participants to preregister**. Ride times will be pre-scheduled, and riders will be encouraged to not show up at the show grounds any earlier than two hours before their ride time and leave as soon as they are done. That way only half of the participants and their accompanied assistants should be at the show grounds at any time.
- 10) **Signage will be posted around the show grounds requiring mask wearing, social distancing and hand washing**.
