Event Description: This is a four-day intensive combined driving clinic. Over the course of the four days, each driver will receive three private 45-minute dressage lessons, two semi-private cones lessons, and two semi-private marathon lessons. In addition there will be clinician talks and walks.

Before registering for this event, please consider the fitness level of your horse at the time of the clinic. This will be an intensive four-day clinic where you will hitch your horse seven times over the course of four days. Making sure your horse is fit and ready to drive twice a day will make this clinic a much more worthwhile and pleasurable event for both you and your horse.

Entry Fees: All fees are in US dollars. Make checks payable to Equestrians Institute.

- Clinic Entry: \$800 entry per driver for clinic entry – includes the lessons and talks/walks with clinician. EI members receive a \$100 discount (\$700 entry fee). This fee includes a navigator, if required by turnout, accompanying the driver during the clinic.
- Clinic Auditing: \$120 fee (\$80 for EI members) to audit the clinic. If participant will not be there all 4 days, \$30 per day (\$20 for EI members). Auditors may not bring horses to this event.
- \$150 stall fee for Sunday through Thursday – includes initial shavings and stall cleaning after the event.

Entries Open: Entries open on February 20th. A deposit of \$250 will hold your place in the clinic. The balance of the fees owed for the clinic is due no later than April 20th. If the balance owed has not been paid by April 20th, your place in clinic will be lost to the wait list, and deposit is forfeited. Deposit is not required for auditors.

Entries Close: Once clinic is full. Watch EI website, www.einw.org for notification that the clinic is full.

Divisions/Turnouts: Training, Preliminary, Intermediate, Advanced

Stall Arrangements:

- Stalls are available Sunday 1 p.m. through Thursday 6 p.m. If you are staying over for the Everything-but-the-Kitchen-Sink event, you will be assigned the same stall.
- Additional bags of shavings available through venue at \$10 per bag. **NO OUTSIDE BEDDING ALLOWED PER FACILITY RULES - \$30 fine for non-compliance.** Exceptions due to allergies must be arranged in advance.
- Daily haul-in is allowed – day stall charge of \$25 per day applies.
- No self stalling.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE: (Detailed schedule with times for all participants will be mailed out prior to event)

Sunday (6/23): Stalls available starting at 1 p.m. No group activities.

Monday (6/24): Each driver will receive a 45-minute private dressage lesson. During lunch time, the clinicians will lead a cones walk. At the end of the day, half of the participants will have a cones lesson. Cones lessons will be in groups of three drivers and will last a total of 45 minutes. Meals not provided – facility concession stand available.

Tuesday (6/25): Each driver will receive a 45-minute private dressage lesson. During lunch time, the clinicians will lead a marathon obstacle walk. At the end of the day, half of the participants will have a cones lesson. Cones lessons will be in groups of three drivers and will last a total of 45 minutes. Meals not provided – facility concession stand available.

Wednesday (6/26): Half of the drivers will receive a 45-minute private dressage lesson and the other half will have a semi-private cones lesson in groups of three drivers for 45 minutes. All participants will have a marathon lesson (groups of three lasting 60 minutes). Meals not provided – facility concession stand available.

Thursday (6/27): Half of the drivers will receive a 45-minute private dressage lesson and the other half will have a semi-private cones lesson in groups of three drivers for 45 minutes. If a driver has a dressage lesson on Wednesday they will have a cones lesson on Thursday and vice versa. All participants will have a marathon lesson (groups of three lasting 60 minutes). Meals not provided – facility concession stand available.

OTHER INFORMATION:

Assignment of Lesson Schedule:

Once your deposit is received, you will be contacted by the organizer regarding preferences for clinician(s) and clinician time slots. Clinic participants will be contacted in order of entries received (by date stamp). The detailed schedule plan will be posted on both the EI website driving page (www.einw.org/pageDriving) and the EI Driving Facebook page.

Safety:

- Medical armbands, or their equivalent such as Road ID, are required at all times for all persons riding on a cart or carriage. Medical armbands will be available for purchase at the show office.
- Per 2019 ADS rules, protective vests are required while on the marathon course.
- Helmets are required during marathon and encouraged to be used at all times while driving.

Veterinary Health Requirements:

To promote health and welfare of all horses, Equestrians Institute complies with ADS rules regarding horse welfare, including but not limited to

- **All equines (except Washington, Oregon, and Idaho) require negative Coggins from no longer ago than June 24, 2018. Vet certificate required for horses coming into Washington State.** Please check with your vet for particulars, as state requirements may change.

Multiple Entries Allowed/Shared Entries Allowed:

Yes, provided scheduling permits. Must be requested with entries to be considered. If you are sharing an entry, please include an entry form for each person, and submit them together.

Refund Policy: Full refund if entry is cancelled prior to April 1st, 2018. After April 1st, full refund minus a \$50 office fee only if place can be filled from the waiting list. No refunds after 72 hours prior to event start.

Misc. Show info:

- No lunging in camping/parking area.
- Please turn off generators after 10 p.m.
- Stalls and camping/parking spots to be assigned. Please list preferences on entry form and we will do our best to accommodate.
- Facility charges a \$30 fee to bring your dog. Payable in the show office and a release must be signed. Dogs must be on leash and under control at all times

Food Available on Grounds:

Concession stand will be available for breakfast and lunch.

Camping on Grounds: Yes, no hook-ups. If you have medical requirements, please contact organizer in advance.

Directions: Donida Farm Equestrian Center is located at 16600 SE 376th St, Auburn, WA. The driving directions provide on the Donida Farm website includes an extremely sharp right hand turn which can be difficult for longer truck and trailer vehicles. To avoid the sharp turn, this route is provided as an alternative.

- If you are coming from I-5, take the Highway 18 exit towards Auburn – exit number 142. If you are coming from I-90, take the Highway 18 exit towards Auburn – exit number 25.
- From highway 18 take the WA-164 E exit toward Enumclaw/Muckleshoot Reservation and turn south onto Auburn Way S/WA-164. It's a right hand turn if you are coming from I-5 and a left hand turn if you are coming from I-90.
- Stay on WA-164 for 4.4 miles.
- Take a slight left onto SE 368th Place. Hamilton Fireworks is a grey building on the corner.
- Follow the road 1.6 miles. It turns multiple times and changes names.
- Turn left into Donida Farm Equestrian Center.
